



End of year teaching arrangements for Year 11

Dear parent/carer

As you are aware year 11 learners have started sitting their final GCSE examinations. We are currently supporting the learners to prepare for the examinations with a combination of regular lessons and additional focussed revision sessions. We have used this system in previous years and this has allowed learners to achieve excellent results.

This year is no different and rest assured that your child will have the best possible support from the school to allow them to fulfil their potential. In order for this to happen all learners will be required to attend school on a full-time basis until Friday 8 June 2018. In other words school will run as normal for all year 11 learners until this date.

From Monday 11 June year 11 learners will be expected to attend lessons for any subjects that is defined to be 'live'. A 'live' subject is one where your child still needs to complete an exam or still needs to complete any controlled assessment such as coursework. For the lessons where a subject is no longer 'live' then your child can either study at home or if they wish study in the school's Learning Zone. Once a learner has completed all their examinations and controlled assessments they will no longer be required to attend lessons.

A reminder that the final time that year 11 learners will meet as a year group is the Year 11 Founders Day on 22 June 2018. Further details of this event will follow in due course.
