Your username is the same, as is your password of ABC- but this must be in capitals so take care.

You can log on to **myOn** and read from a **phone, laptop or tablet** so there are plenty of opportunities to read for the suggested reading time of at least **15- 20 minutes per day.**

If you haven't started quizzing yet, now is your chance!

Challenge 1: Over Easter, log on, get started and read and quiz on at least ONE book. Simple.



Challenge 2: Become familiar with the website, try out the different tools and set up a book list on your account of perhaps 3 books you might like to read in the future.




Getting Started:

1. Log on to the following website <https://www.myon.co.uk/login/index.html>
2. Enter the school name Lliswerry High School (this will appear as you begin to type)



You will find the link on the learner links on the school website too:



Enter your details.

This will be the same username that you use for Accelerated Reader.

Username: first initial and first 4 letters of your surname (maybe a number)

Password: ABC (THIS MUST BE IN CAPITALS)

If you can't remember your username or password, email your teacher and they will remind you.





Next, you need to link your reading age and ZPD (book level) to your existing AR account.




sound: verb
