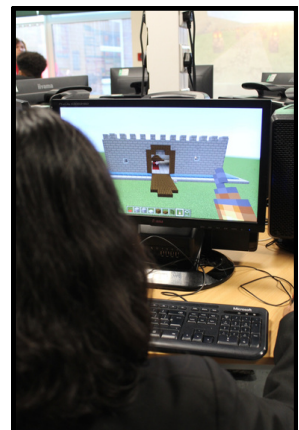

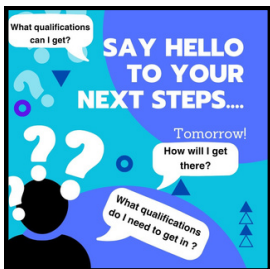
Here is the link to the **Year 9 Pathways Information** folder so parents and carers can access the information directly themselves.
