Headteacher's Update

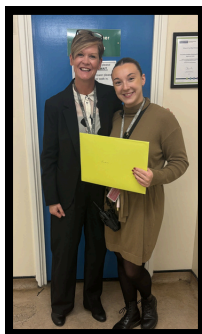
Dear Parents and Carers,
