Unfortunately Year 10 bow out of the Newport Cup at the quarter-final stage losing on a penalty shootout after a 1-1 draw with Caldicot High School.

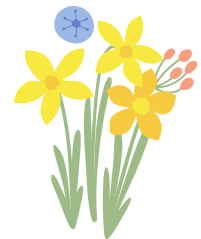
