Thank you to all who participated and to Mrs. James-Williams and Mrs. Maynard for all your hard work in planning and preparing the learners.

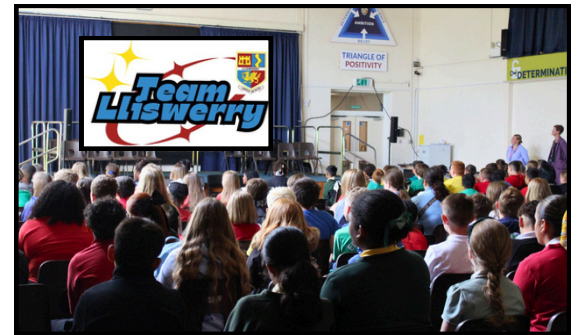


New Year 7 Parents Evening and Move Up day
