Year 7 played their second game of the year. Although they lost 7-4, the ability within the team is amazing and they are always motivated to play on.

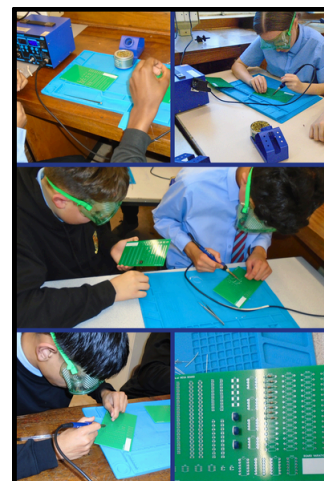


On Wednesday, A-level Chemistry and Biology girls from Lliswerry and Llanwern visited the University of South Wales. The event was organised by the Engineering Education Scheme Wales to provide and opportunity for learners to tour the university facilities, see the teaching laboratories and experience talks and activities led by female academics working in marine biology, forensic science and pharmaceutical science. Included learning about coral conservation in Honduras, forensic techniques and the science of fingerprinting and using their sense of smell to identify chemicals and see if anyone has a future as a perfume tester!



Semi Conductor Workshop

Last Friday lingo solutions along with CS Connected delivered a semi conductor workshop. Learners were given a presentation on semi conductors and were shown how to use soldering equipment. The learners were each given a printed circuit board, soldering irons and components. They then used their newly developed soldering techniques such as through hole soldering and surface mount soldering to attach their components to their boards.
