




Year 10 Football



Girls Get Set

On Thursday, girls from Years 8 and 9 took part in an online masterclass delivered by GKN Aerospace, exploring the environmental impact of powered flight. They examined a range of ways engineers are working to minimise this impact, particularly by reducing flight emissions. The session also explored how alternative fuel sources could replace traditional aviation fuel, including hydrogen, batteries, and sustainable fuels such as waste oil and biomass, to help reduce carbon emissions. To conclude, the girls were asked to consider these solutions and incorporate them into their own design ideas.
