Well done to Grace S. who recently competed at the recent Future Chef Regional Final held at Cardiff Stadium.

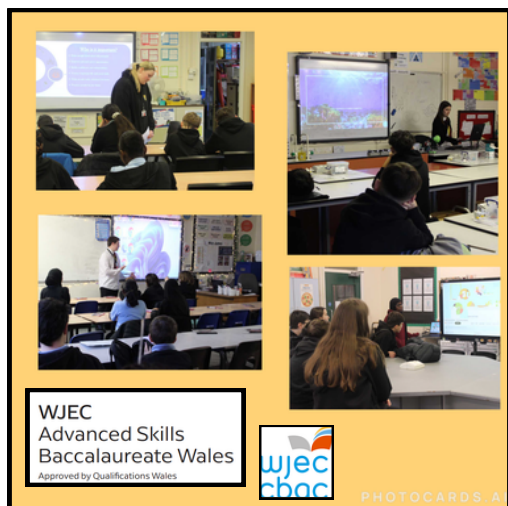

Year 12 Skills Challenge

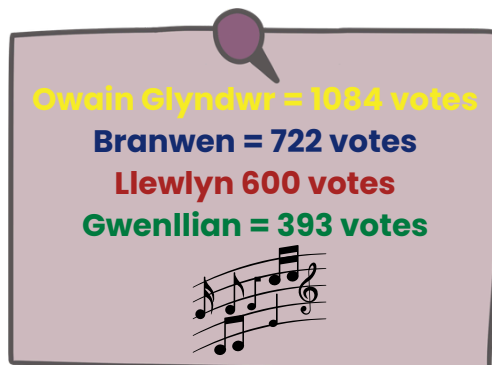
