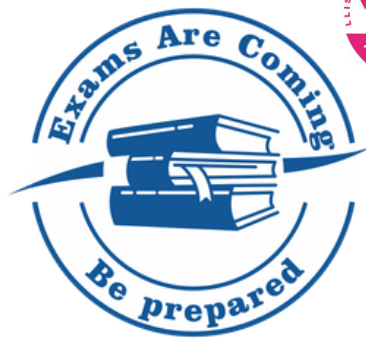

Tuesday 5th May**



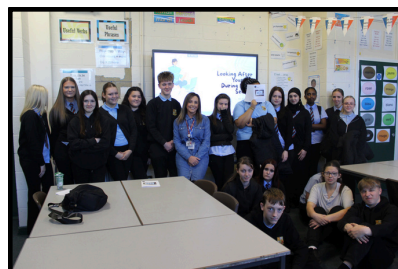
All learners in Years 10,11,12,13 have been given their exam timetables. Please can you check it with them so that you are aware and can support them.
