Young Carers

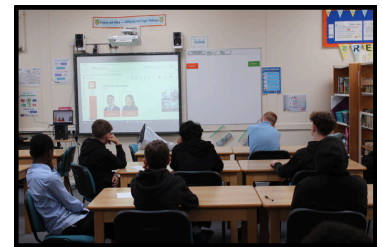
Young Carers Week

On Wednesday, several Year 9 pupils took part in a virtual workshop, "Why Not Law?", which encouraged them to consider careers in the legal sector.

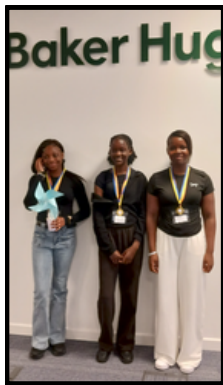

Biscuit or cake - what do you think?



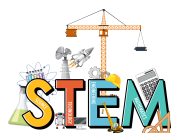
Efforts to High Things

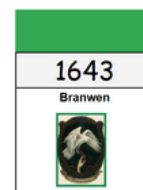


House winners - Gwenllian winners
